

Easy Peasy Santa Strawberries

12 large, plump strawberries

1 cup whipped cream cheese

2 Tbls. powdered sugar

1/4 tsp. vanilla

Red and black icing for the eyes and nose



Wash strawberries and cut off/discard stems to make a flat bottom. Then slice off the pointy portion to make Santa's hat. Restack hat and body on a decorative holiday serving plate.

In a small bowl, mix the cream cheese, powdered sugar, and vanilla. Spoon mixture into a piping bag with a large star tip.

Remove hat and gently squeeze a generous amount of mixture onto Santa's body. Make sure there's enough height to add a face. Place hat on top and add the hat's pom-pom.

Finish the face using decorative black and red icing for Santa's eyes and mouth. Keep refrigerated until served. Yum!



- 2 tsp. vanilla syrup
- 1/4 tsp. nutmeg
- 2 oz. espresso (or 8 oz. brewed coffee)

Froth the eggnog mixture until foamy, and set aside.

Brew your espresso (or coffee) and pour into a coffee mug.

Top with the frothed eggnog mixure. Sprinkle with nutmeg or top with whipped cream, or both!
